ARTIFICIAL DIAMONDS.

Positive Announcement of the Successful Crys-
tallization of Carbon.

LONDON, Feb. 23.—Prof. Nevil Story
Maskelyne of the Mineral Department of the
British Museum, writes to the Times announc-
ing the entire success of Mr. J. Ballantyne Han-
nay of Glasgow, a Fellow of the Chemical
Society of London, in producing diamonds. He
says Mr. Hannay sent him some crystallized
particles presenting exactly the appearance of
fragments of a broken diamond, and these frag-
ments easily scored deep grooves in the polished
surface of a sapphire. Mr. Hannay's pro-
cess will soon be announced to the Royal
Society.

In his letter Prof. Story-Maskelyne, after de-
scribing the various tests applied, gives as
follows: "There is no doubt whatever that Mr.
J. Ballantyne Hannay has succeeded in solving
the problem and removing from scientific chem-
istry the anachronism so long adhering to it,
for, whereas the larger part of the great volume
recorded the triumphs of that science is occu-
pied by the chemistry of carbon, this element
has never been crystallized by man till Mr.
Hannay achieved the triumph which I have the
pleasure of recording to-day. His process for
effecting this transmutation is hardly less im-
portant to the arts than to the possessors of a
wealth of jewelry. It is on the eve of being an-
nounced to the Royal Society."

COCKING MAIN NEAR ALBANY.

Legislators, Lawyers, Merchants, and Bank-
ers Among the Spectators.

ALBANY, Feb. 20.—A cocking main oc-
curred last night at a popular resort on the
Troy road. The contesting birds were owned
by residents of Albany and Saratoga Counties.
The former were handled by a West Troy
and the others by an Albanian. About 150 per-
sons were present, including several members
of the Legislature, prominent lawyers, brokers,
merchants, and persons holding important
public positions. The betting from the start
was in favor of the Saratoga birds. The main

West Troy won the second, third, and fifth, and
Saratoga the first, fourth, sixth, seventh, and
eighth battles. At the conclusion of the main
an odd battle was fought, resulting in a victory
for the West Troy bird. The betting was extra-
ordinarily heavy. The decision of the referee
on the fifth battle was disputed. The West Troy
fowl had one leg broken, but still showed signs.
None of the battles lasted over fifteen minutes.
